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The Principal's Summary of GCSE results for 2017

We would like to congratulate the class of 2017 on their achievement and progress in this year's GCSE results. We are proud that in previous years all students have been able to move on to relevant education, employment or training as a result of their outcomes at Charlton School.

Our aim at Charlton is to provide a broad and balanced curriculum which allows students to achieve qualifications in the core subjects, English and Mathematics; together with the suite of Ebaac subjects including Science, Geography and History, Modern Foreign languages and Computer Science. In addition, there are opportunities to gain GCSEs in Technology, Expressive Arts, ICT, PE, Media Studies and ICT.

The Department for Education have introduced a new method of measuring both achievement and progress of all students within every school. In addition, the grading system for English and Maths has changed to the new 9-1 system, while the rest of the subjects remain on the A* - C system.

The five main Headline Figures for Charlton School are as follows:

- The percentage of students who achieved a Grade 5 pass in English (either Language or Literature) and Mathematics was 42%.
- The percentage of students who achieved a Grade 4 pass in English (either Language or Literature) and Mathematics was 60%.
- The percentage of students who achieved the Ebaac qualification (English and Maths at grade 5, two Science subjects, History or Geography and a Modern Foreign language) was 26%.
- The average total Attainment 8 (A8) score was 43.4.
- The Progress 8 (P8) score aims to capture the progress a pupil makes from the end of primary school to the end of secondary school in a selected set of 8 subjects. This is currently not known until the average estimated Attainment 8 figure is arrived at, based on the 2017 GCSE results of pupils with similar prior attainment.

The tables below give a grade breakdown of firstly English and Maths (9-1) and then the rest of the subjects (A* - C).
