Dear Parent / Carers of Year 9 students.

Please find detailed below the arrival times for students to attend school to receive their first lateral flow test. In addition, attached to this email are a privacy statement we are asked to share with you by the NHS and an instruction leaflet on how to conduct your test.

Whilst participating in the testing programme is voluntary, to protect our school community, we are urging all parents to give consent for their child to take part in the lateral flow testing process. To consent please complete a form at the link below:

Students should attend school at the times indicated in the table below. They should wear a face mask throughout their time on the school site, sanitise their hands on entry to the building and again when instructed to do so by the staff leading the testing programme. Students do not need to wear uniform when coming in for the testing session.

Unfortunately, we are unable to provide school transport for those who access this for the testing programme and seek your support on this occasion to transport your child to school to school if necessary, to enable your child to access the testing at the appropriate time. The full school transport routes will be in operation for when students return to school after their tests, students are reminded of the need to use face coverings on all bus journeys.

Students will enter and leave site through the main school reception, they do not need to sign in at reception, registration will take place in the main hall. Students are to leave site immediately after the test has been conducted and not breach social distancing guidelines.

Unless a student receives a positive test result, all students in Year 8 are due to return to school on Wednesday 10th March, ready to enter site via the main entrance at 8:45am.
