Equality of men and women in the family: Genesis 1 says men and women are equal. Genesis 2-3 says women are subordinate to men. St Paul said women should submit to their husbands (but husbands must love their wives) Evangelical Protestants say men should be providers while women stay home and bring up children

Liberal Protestants say men and women should have equal and interchangeable roles. Catholics say men and women should have different but equal roles. *Non-religious* people tend to say men and women should be completely equal.

Gender Prejudice and Discrimination:

Believing one gender is superior to another, discrimination occurs when it is put into practice. (Sexism) God is described as male, all the main characters in the Bible are male, as were those who wrote it, Jesus

and all his disciples were male. Some say this makes Christianity inherently sexist. Evangelicals say men & women have different roles so don't have equal rights when it comes to religion (Genesis 2 says Adam was created first so wives should submit to their husbands etc.)
