## **DESIGN AND TECHNOLOGY PROGRAMME CONTRIBUTION**

This year we wish to offer all students a programme of study involving a wide range of Design and Make assignments. The department wishes to offer as many opportunities as possible to make products that the students find exciting and are proud to take home. This involves using a variety of materials that add a cost to the department e.g. plastics, wood, metal, electronics, textiles and food.

Our experience is that most children wish to take things home as presents or evidence of their work, to give to members of their family. At Key Stage 3 (Years 7-9), we will be asking you to contribute £18 per student for the whole academic year. Students will not be asked to provide any further contribution during the year, and we will now provide basic food recipe ingredients as part of this contribution. We feel that this contribution is excellent value for money, as it represents a cost of £4.50 per Technology project completed during the academic year.

At Key Stage 4 (Years 10 - 11), we will be asking you to contribute £18 per student for the academic year. Students will not be asked to make any further contributions, except for any specific materials required individually for controlled assessment practical work. If your son/daughter takes two Technology subjects at GCSE, we would expect a contribution payment for each Technology subject. **Students who take a Food course will not be expected to make a contribution due to the food recipe requirements needed each week.** 

This will not recover all expenditure involved in the making of these items but will enable us to recoup a small percentage of the total costs involved, thus allowing us to deliver a more varied and innovative Technology experience.
