UNIFORM LIST 2022 - 2023

School Tie The school tie incorporates the House Colours.
(Sycamore – Red, Willow – Green, Birch – Yellow & Hawthorn – Blue).
The tie should be worn with 5 double stripes visible or the width of a piece of A4 below the knot
(approximately 21cm)

Years 7 - 11 Navy blazer with school crest in blue* (*Compulsory*) or sew-on badges can be purchased from Baker and Son and sewn onto a plain navy blue blazer.
Navy V-neck pullover with school crest* (*Optional to be worn under the blazer*)
Plain blue/black out-door coat (*no leather or denim*)

Year 11 students wear a white shirt to identify them as the senior year group.

** Available with school logo from school supplier*

BOYS:

- Pale blue shirt (Years 7 - 10)
- White shirt (Year 11)
- Plain black trousers (not jeans)
- Black/grey socks
- Plain black shoes (No trainers or canvas type shoes)

GIRLS:

- Pale blue shirt - Rever collar is not allowed (Years 7 - 10)
- White shirt - Rever collar is not allowed (Year 11)
- Black tailored trousers (not skinny trousers – straight leg only), or Black knee length pleated skirt. *For existing students blue trousers/skirts will be accepted until September 2023.*
- Black or white socks OR black tights
- Plain black flat walking shoes – Max. heel height 4cms. Max Sole 2cms

Muslim Students

Our Muslim students have slight amendments to their dress code:-

- Girls may wear a navy blue hijab and a navy blue kameez, abaya or maxi skirt with black trousers. They are expected to wear a tie and blazer with their kameez, abaya or maxi skirt.
- Muslim boys should all wear the normal school uniform

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Any other sports clothing will not be permitted during PE lessons or in extra-curricular activities

Any items of PE kit can be personally initialled for a cost of £3 via Baker and Son

** Available with school logo from school supplier, unbranded items can also be worn.*

If any students have sensory needs and our uniform policy causes problems for them, please contact the child's Pastoral Manager to discuss what adaptations can be made for them.

We would also like to outline the following issues related to uniform and student appearance.

1. Students not participating in active P.E. lessons are still required to bring their P.E. kit with them to school. Alternative arrangements will be made for these students. Towels are required for showering - Please note that aerosol cans are **not** allowed on the premises, this means roll-on deodorants must be used instead of the spray variety.
2. Students should not replace items of uniform with other fashion accessories, i.e. sweaters with hoodies, etc.
3. Students should take pride in their uniform and wear it correctly. Coats and other items should not be worn as a replacement of the blazer/jumper. This includes days where students wear PE kit.
4. Shoes should be plain black and logo free. Black trainers are not permitted. Shoes with Velcro fastenings are allowed. Slingback, boots, or clog type footwear are not permitted. Canvas type footwear is not appropriate, as during the winter months students' feet become wet and uncomfortable throughout the day. This has resulted in a number of cases where students have had to contact parents to bring alternative footwear into school.

Trainers may not be worn in School at anytime. They should not be worn to and from School. A Doctor's note is required for the wearing of trainers for medical reasons.

5. The approved skirt is a black knee length pleated design. This must not be tight fitting and the hem of the skirt must be on the knee. Trousers must be straight leg only. Skinny fit or tight trousers are not acceptable.
6. Jewellery is not permitted except for one pair of small gold or silver studs earrings worn in the ear lobe (no jewels). Other piercings are not allowed.
7. Cosmetics other than a **discreet** amount or mascara or foundation for girls should not be worn. Eyebrows should be natural and not tinted.
8. Nail varnish and nail extensions are not allowed in school. Students are involved in many activities and again, nail extensions can cause injury.
9. **Excessive** hairstyles, shaved patterns, panels or lines, non-natural hair colour and false eyelashes are not permitted.
10. Any student whose appearance represents an **extreme** of fashion, as determined by the Senior Leadership Team, will be deemed to have isolated themselves from the school until their appearance is suitable.
11. Breaches of uniform may constitute: (examples only) *Incorrect footwear, Non regulation skirt or trousers, Shaved patterns or extreme hairstyles, Jewellery, piercings other than in ear lobes, non-natural hair colour, bracelets or charity bands.* For such breaches students will be deemed to have removed themselves from mainstream school until their appearance is deemed acceptable. For repeated instances the School Exclusion Policy may then be applied.
12. Temporary breaches of uniform must be supported by a parental signed note. The note must also be countersigned by the student's Pastoral Manager. This will count as a first instance. For a second instance in each half term students will be deemed to have removed themselves from mainstream school until their appearance is compliant. For repeated instances the School Exclusion Policy may then be applied.

If there are persistent cases of uniform breach, then a student may be placed in the Behaviour Recovery Room or in another suitable location away from mainstream lessons depending on room availability. Possible reasons for not authorising permission may be as follows; forged note, deliberate attempt to deceive or violate the rules. There may be other reasons that will apply depending on particular circumstances.
