Years 8, 9 and 10 on Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday

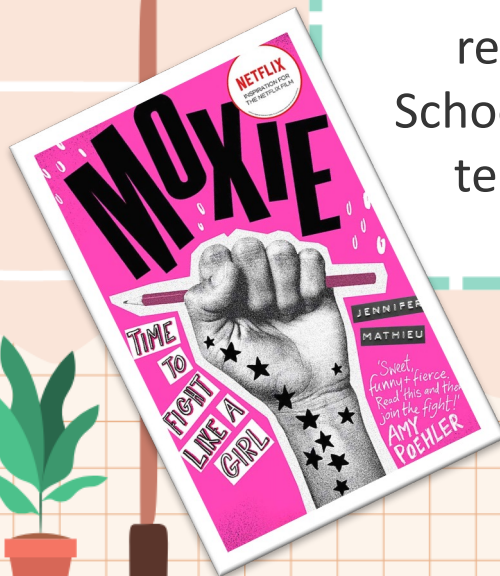




BOOK OF THE WEEK

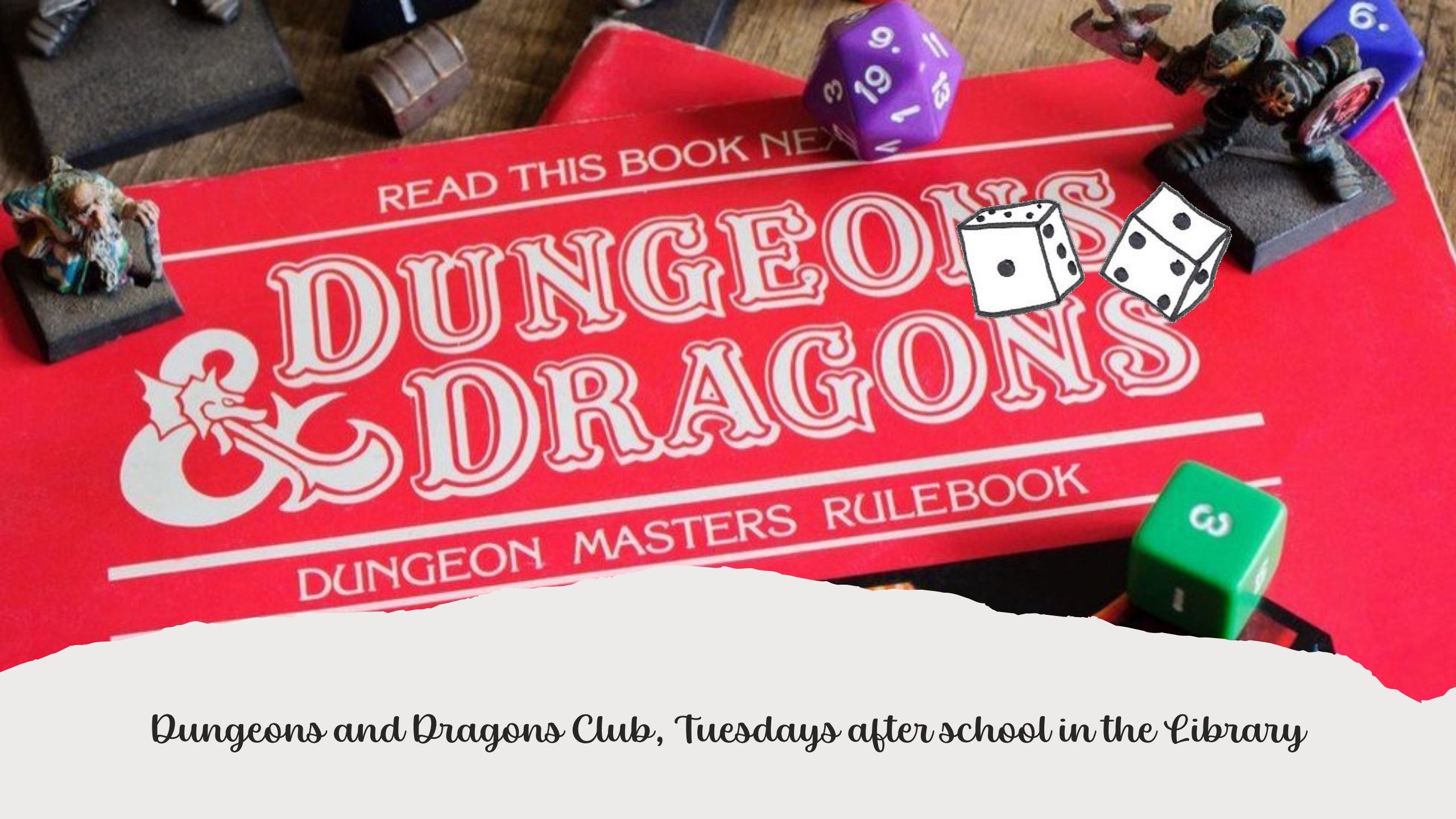

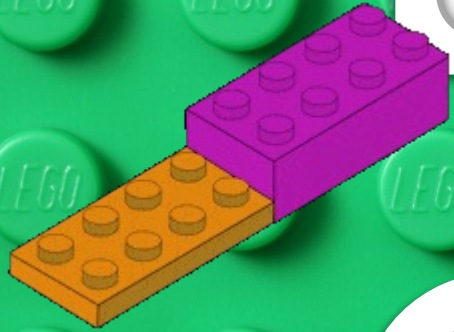

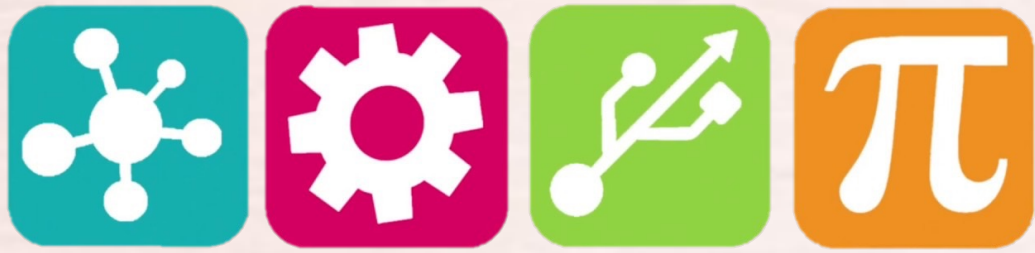
